Those who live in the shelter of the Most High will find rest in the shadow of the Almighty.

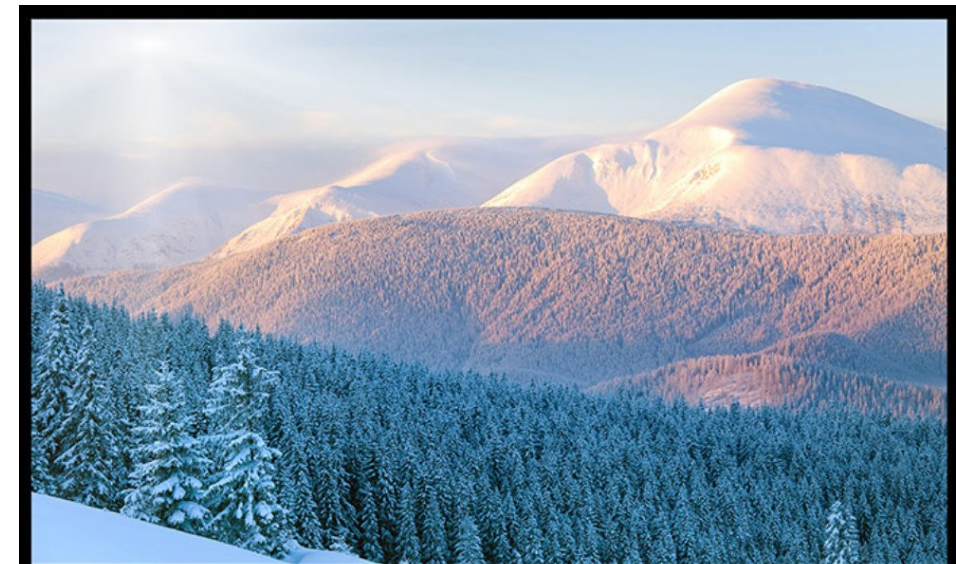
This I declare about the Lord
