OUR COMMITTEES

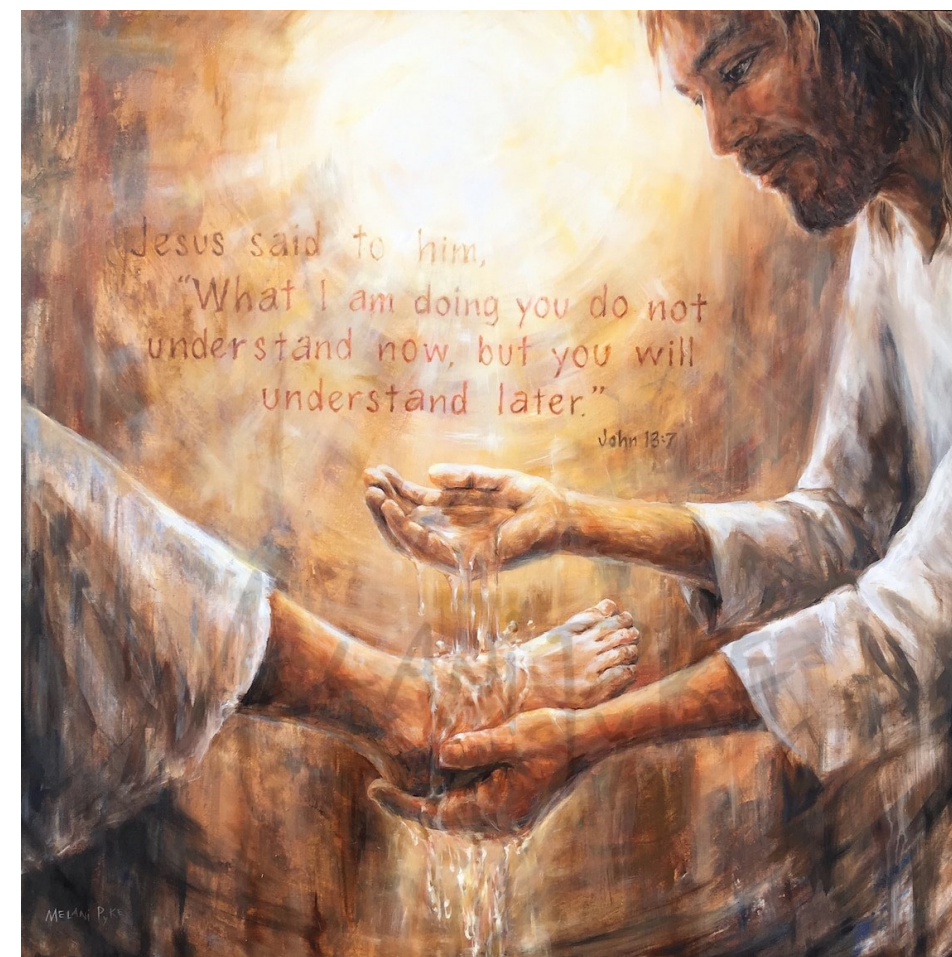
